As we mentioned in our March newsletter; **our vision** is to build 18 Baseball and Softball fields and make them available to teams and kids in south-central Kansas.

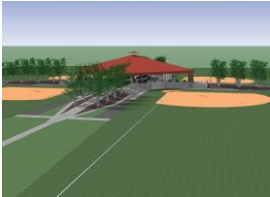
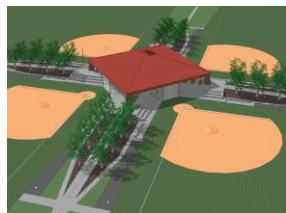


Each field can accommodate **240** softball or baseball players each year and for each year after that. Upon completion of the entire facility, up to **4,000** kids will be able to participate each week.

**To date** we have committed approximately \$800,000 in resources: To provide Architectural concepts and designs as well as Civil Engineering.
