

Groundbreaking announcement

Central Plains Youth Sports (CPYS) is proud to announce the ground breaking of the new little league baseball and softball sports facility at 29th and Greenwich road. We cordially invite you to attend the ground breaking ceremony on June 13th around 2:30. Please “save this date” and plan on attending the beginning of the next generation of youth sports facilities in this community.

Central Plains Youth Sports is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to providing affordable options for baseball and softball league and tournament play in South Central Kansas.

The project will include constructing up to 18 fields on approximately 60 acres of park land owned by the city of Wichita. The sports complex will be built in three phases, to allow organizers to generate revenue along the way to pay for development of the following phase.

Phase one includes construction of six baseball fields to serve youth from the ages of five through 10. Phase two consists of an additional three fields to be completed approximately two years after phase one. Phase three consists of an additional nine fields to be completed approximately four years later, bringing the total number of fields to 18.

The fields will support both league play and tournament play for youth in all skill levels in baseball and softball. In addition, the fields will provide an opportunity to stage National tournaments for teams all across the country, bringing them to Wichita to compete at the highest level. The sports complex will also offer clinics, camps and individual instruction, providing young ball players opportunities to develop their skills.

In addition to supporting youth baseball and softball well into the future, the sports complex will have a significant economic impact to the community. Local restaurants, hotels, shops and theatres will all benefit as out of town ball players and their families come to Wichita for tournaments.
